Besides Hardtop, 3-Door 2+2, Ghia and Mach 1 newness, there's spectacular Stallion styling in 2+2 and Hardtop versions, and an exciting new Cobra II. What's more, Mustang II's have Ford Lifeguard Design Safety Features.

Well-built. Mustang II is built durably. Galvanized parts, zinc metal door panels and a 6-step paint process help fight rust. Further quality touches: good body fits and handsomely tailored interiors.

Better mileage. For 1976, Ford has engineered its cars for better overall fuel economy than 1975 models. See your Ford Dealer for details on 1976 EPA mileage ratings.

Ford means value. Competitive pricing and popularity have helped keep trade-in value high. You also get impressive standards. See the list on the back cover.

Mustang II 3-Door 2+2. Say good-bye to boredom.

Our 4-passenger 2+2, with rear liftgate, is sure to open the door to a whole new exciting world. The rear seat folds down for 22.8 cubic feet to carry skis, scuba gear, whatever. Bucket seats come in easy-care vinyl. A 2.3 liter 2V overhead cam engine mates economically with a 4-speed manual. Front disc brakes, rack and pinion steering are standard.



But the real news is this. You have two great new ways to order the 2+2. First consider the exciting new Stallion 2+2 below, in Bright Yellow (Code 6E), with dramatic Stallion touches like: Black grille • Black moldings and wiper arms • bright lower bodyside molding • Black-painted lower fenders, lower doors, lower front/rear bumpers, rocker panels • styled steel wheels. Four other color-and-Black combinations are available. See Stallion, page 3. If you prefer bright, shiny chrome

instead—plus a bold, bright grille . . . order the 2+2 as it comes. And wait until you fun-drive 2+2. It moves like a dream and is easy to own. (Trim rings, dual remote mirrors, bumper guards, and V-8 are optional.)

Standard interior (left) seats four comfortably on low-back bucket seats tailored in Medium Blue (Code AB) vinyl. Bright Red, Tan or Black also available.

Mustang II Hardtops, lowest-priced models in the line, traditionally have been America's best-selling sports luxury cars. There are good reasons why they should set the pace again. You can order sporty styling in the bright chrome, bright grille version. Or, you can get your Hardtop decked out in dramatic Stallion Blackout treatment.

Interior beauty says comfort. With deep-cushioned low-back bucket seats nicely tailored in vinyl. Thick cut-pile carpeting. Woodtone appliques. Tachometer, odometer, fuel, ammeter and temperature gauges. True class. Luxurious. And standard.

The sporty floor shift, 4-speed manual transmission puts you smoothly in touch with a thrifty 2.3 liter 2V engine. For more exciting go, here and on the 2+2's, you can order the 2.8 liter 2V V-6. A spirited 302 CID 2V V-8 is also available with the responsive

SelectShift Cruise-O-Matic transmission. All engines come with solid state ignition. So tune-ups are simpler, with no point/condenser replacement. Fewer scheduled maintenance stops also help you save on service. The sporty, bright-chrome-styled Hardtop is illustrated below, in Red (Code 2R). But driving, of course, is better than seeing. You get Black super-soft vinyl (Code BA) shown, or a choice of Westminster cloth and vinyl trim • large armrests • deluxe door and rear seat quarter trim • courtesy lights • color-keyed deluxe belts • plush 18-oz. cut-pile carpeting • super sound package. Bright Red, Medium Blue, Tan, Creme and White super-soft vinyl also available. Westminster cloth also comes beautifully in Medium Blue, Black, Tan or Bright Red. Mustang II Mach 1 plus exciting new Cobra II and Tu-Tone options

Be the talk of the town—or the local rally. Drive up in any of three new dazzlers: exhilarating Mach 1, Cobra II, or Stallion 2+2 with upbeat Tu-Tone.

Mach 1, shown below, gives you Red (2R) with Black lower bodysides, lower bumpers, deck lid, bright grille, bright window moldings, color-keyed dual remote mirrors. And racy touches like styled steel wheels plus RWL radials. A 2.8 liter 2V V-6 and 4-speed manual with floor shift are also standard. Options: 302 V-8, trim rings.

(A) Cobra II. Cobra strikes again! Built for today, it's smaller, more economical than its famous predecessor. But all Cobra underneath. Standards include: racing stripes • front/rear spoilers • non-functional air scoop • Cobra emblem • dual remote mirrors • 2.8 liter 2V V-6 • 4-speed manual with floor shift • front disc brakes • styled steel wheels/trim rings • RWL radials. Inside: Black, Blue or White vinyl trim, brushed metal accents, Cobra II nameplates. Polar White (9D) shown with Blue stripes. Surprisingly, Cobra II is a very affordable car.

(B) Sterling Plaid Cloth Trim makes the Luxury Interior Group sportier. Bright Red (Code ED) shown. Plaid also comes in Blue, Tan or Creme. SelectShift, AM Radio are optional.

(C) Tu-Tone Option on Stallion 2+2 in Silver Metallic and Black (Code 1G) includes Black hood and roof. Available, also, on 2+2 and Mach 1 models. Tu-Tone comes Black with Red, Polar White, Bright Yellow or Silver Blue Glow. Dual mirrors, pivoting rear quarter windows, bumper guards, RWL radials, forged aluminum wheels are optional.
