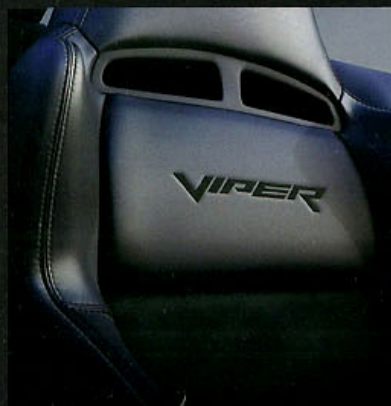
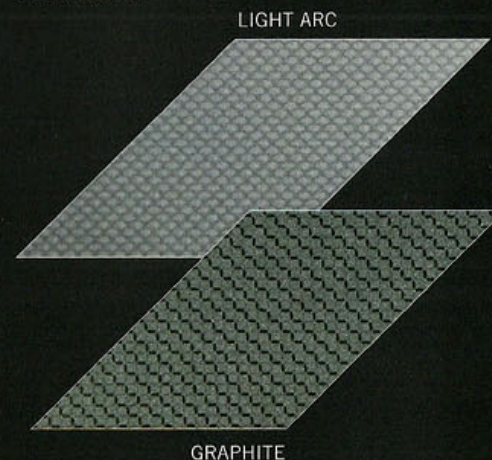
THE 2010 DODGE VIPER SRT10 CUSTOMIZATION OPTIONS

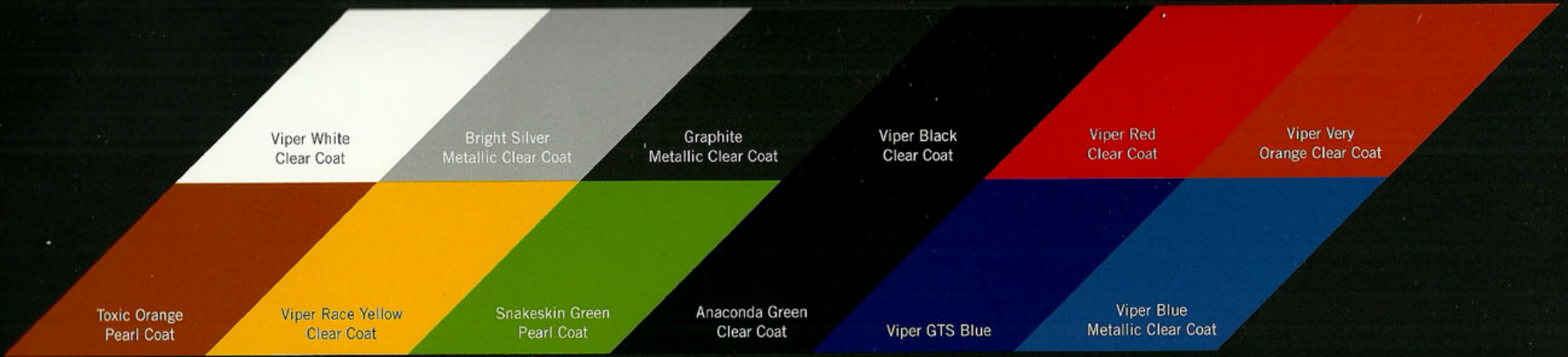

THE 2010 DODGE VIPER SRT10 ACR

Improved driver control and feel is at the heart of the 2010 Dodge Viper SRT10 ACR. A short-throw shifter enhances the driver experience, especially when coupled with the redesigned rear wing profile and endplates which optimize vehicle aerodynamics and improve rear yaw downforce. When combined with the new fifth gear ratio, the ACR's top speed increases by 4 mph. The ACR models also feature a carbon-fiber fanged splitter in front and an adjustable seven-position carbon wing that works together to produce an awe-inspiring 1,000 lbs. of downforce at 150 mph.

The Viper ACR's enhanced four-wheel independent suspension features high-performance aluminum control arms and knuckles, and a KW suspension with two-way adjustable competition coil-over shock absorbers with remote reservoirs. Lightweight wheels, two-piece slotted StopTech brake rotors and Michelin PS Cup tires complete the Dodge Viper ACR—a race enthusiast's dream come true.

The ACR has a proven track record with extraordinary lap times at two of the world's most challenging and celebrated racetracks—7:22 at Germany's Nürburgring and only 1:33 at Laguna Seca. Now you can take the wheel of a true speed machine with the street-legal Dodge Viper ACR.

THE 2010 DODGE VIPER SRT10 ACR-X

Astronauts, fighter pilots and professional racers know it as the X-dimension. It's the point at which a vehicle reaches a velocity so intense, reality itself seems like a slow-moving mirage. It's for these speed junkies that Dodge created the 2010 Dodge Viper SRT10 ACR-X.

The ultimate combination of the street-legal Viper ACR and the track-only Viper Competition Coupe, the ACR-X churns out a heart-stopping 640 hp, pushed to the limit with a variety of modifications including headers and a low-restriction exhaust system. Track-tuned suspension and aerodynamics, plus a factory-designed roll cage, fuel cell and race seat mark the ACR-X as a serious racing contender, for serious racers who demand extreme performance.

During the development of the ACR-X, spectacular lap times were posted at Mosport (1:20.6), Sebring (2:08.72) and Moroso (1:17.14).

With all that power at the ready, Viper ACR-X owners put their racing skills to the test in the Dodge Viper Cup, sanctioned by the Viper Racing League. After all, the only thing better than entering the X-dimension is beating another driver to it.

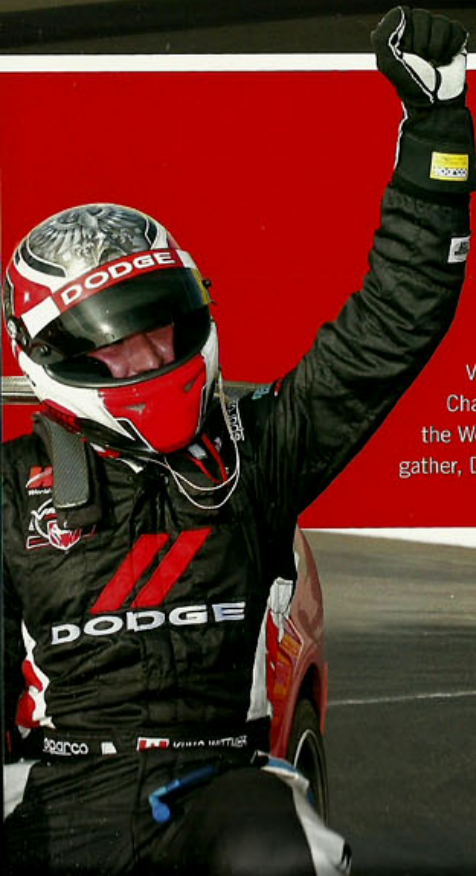
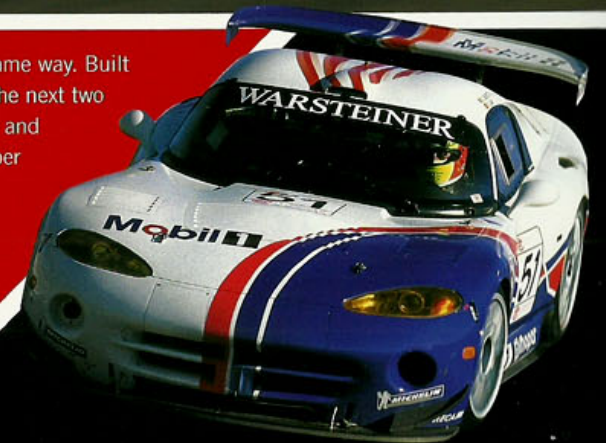

DODGE VIPER: THE DOMINANT RACING MACHINE



On the street, you're lucky to catch a glimpse of a Dodge Viper. Competitors on the track feel the same way. Built to dominate, the Viper's winning tradition is rich for a vehicle so young. Starting in 1997, and for the next two years, Viper won the FIA GT Driver and Manufacturers Championships. In 1998 Viper finished first and second in its GTS class at the 24 Hours of Le Mans and repeated in 1999 and 2000. In 1999 Viper was so dominant at Le Mans, it swept the top six spots. Additionally, in 1999 and 2000 Viper won the American Le Mans Series Team and Driver Championships. In 2000 Viper became the first American-built production GT to take the overall first place in the Rolex 24 Hours at Daytona.

At the dawn of the 21st century, Viper continues to rewrite the record books. In 2004, Viper took the SCCA World Challenge Championship. 2004 and 2006 brought Viper a Championship in Formula Drift. In 2010, Viper has already driven away with first place at the World Challenge Race in Long Beach. And tomorrow? Wherever premier sports cars gather, Dodge Viper will be there to school them all.

Few people who visited the North American International Auto Show in 1989 expected to see a prototype that would become a legend. None, even today, are likely to forget it. The 1992 Dodge Viper came in one model: RT/10 Roadster, one speed: fast, and one color: red. Having built a runaway hit, the Dodge engineers did what they do best. They upped the ante. In the coming years, the Dodge Viper would see four refresh/redesigns. Larger, more powerful V-10 engines would be paired with larger, more capable brakes. Aerodynamics and driver feedback would steadily improve. Available models increased and customization options expanded. Today's Dodge Viper is just as recognizable as the first, sharing a heritage built on power, engineering and a quest for exceptional performance. In 18 years, the Viper has reached adulthood. No wonder the competition is running scared.
