
The Camaro for 1973. We think it's one beautifully styled automobile.

There's room for four people or a small family in a car that really hugs the road.

There's a modest initial price and a wide selection of options you can choose to make your own kind of Camaro.

And this year, there's even a new top-of-the-line Camaro called the Type LT. The Type LT, the Z28 and the standard Camaro, along with the available Rally Sport package, give you a choice of four different looks and feels.

Camaro. You're probably much closer to owning one than you thought.

The Camaro Type LT. The "L" is for Luxury, the "T" is for Touring.

This newest Camaro is built for people who like their luxury and their sporty handling all in the same car.

The Type LT comes with a Turbo-Fire 350 V8 engine and variable-ratio power steering. On the driver's side, there's a remote-control sport mirror while on the passenger side there's an identical manually operated sport mirror.

Type LT identification appears on the front, roof rear quarter and rear end panel. Hide-A-Way windshield wipers tuck neatly out of the way when not in use. Black-finished body sills underneath the doors accent Camaro's low profile. E78 x 14 tires are mounted on 14 x 7 Rally Wheels with centre caps and trim rings. From the outside, Type LT looks like something special. And inside, it's even more so.

The Camaro Sport Coupe. You deserve a car this good.

Camaro's long hood/short deck design give it a distinctive look that does you proud. Behind the wheel, you gain an even greater appreciation of the Camaro Sport Coupe. Its precise handling and excellent ride control result from a combination of good things. Like independent front coil suspension. Multi-leaf rear springs with biasmounted shock absorbers. A wide tread, wide-rim 14 x 6 wheels and large E78 x 14 tires. The Camaro Sport Coupe is made to give you pure driving pleasure.

The inside story is equally impressive. Fullfoam molded front and rear seats provide extra riding comfort. You get door-to-door deep-twist carpeting. There's even stowage pockets molded in the door panels.

The Camaro Sport Coupe gives you a choice of Six or V8 power. And disc brakes on the front wheels are standard.

New stronger front bumper with stronger mounting. Front bumper guards with resilient inserts for added protection (except with Rally Sport).



Side-guard door beams are welded into every door for protection against side



Four-spoke sport steering wheel makes getting behind the wheel of a Camaro more fun than ever.

High-back Strate-bucket front seats with built-in head restraints are full-foam

molded for extra riding comfort and firm support. So are the bucket-styled seats in back.



Front disc brakes for excellent direction control during braking. They provide resistance to fade and recover quickly from water immersion.

Sport nameplates just behind the front wheel wells.

The grille itself is surrounded by a resilient frame which protects against dings and dents. There are bumpers on either side of the grille.

To maintain the clean look of the grille, the license plate mounting is below the driver's right bumper. The parking lights are moved from under the bumper to a position next to the headlights and take on a roadlight style. Rally Sport also features Hide-A-Way windshield wipers.

The Rally Sport package can be ordered with the standard Camaro Sport Coupe, the LT or the Z28.

THE CAMARO Z28. (Background) Better known simply as "The Z". It's for those who demand a little more performance. And it'll give you all you ask for.

The Z28 features a new Turbo-Fire

like all Chevrolet engines, it runs on regular, no-lead or low-lead gas. This year, the Z28 is available with either the manual 4-Speed or Turbo Hydra-matic transmisson. And air conditioning is available with either transmission for the first time.

Other "Z" features worth mentioning, all standard: sport suspension, special 15 x 7 wheels and F60 x 15 whitelettered tires, power brakes, positraction, a black-finish grille, sport mirrors on both sides and Z28 identification.

The Standard Camaro Interior

combines a sporty feel with room for four. High-back Strato-bucket seats in front and the rear seat are all full-foam molded. Seat covering is available in your choice of two mixed-tone clothand-vinyl combinations (black/white or black/blue) plus five all-vinyl selections (black, dark green, dark

The Camaro Type LT Interior has luxury all its own.

It begins with full-foam molded bucket seats in front and the full-foam molded rear seat. They give you the maximum in riding comfort. Seats are covered in your choice of three mixedtone cloth-and-vinyl combinations (black/white, black/blue or black/ green) plus two all-vinyl selections (black or neutral.)

The Type LT is equipped with the new Interior Decor/Quiet Sound Group which reduces interior noise level with additional sound-deadening insulation. The Camaro Type LT instrument panel is luxurious looking and functional. It features wood-grain and silver-finish accents. Full instrumentation includes, tachometer, ammeter and temperature gauge plus an electric clock. A new soft-rim, four-spoke steering wheel adds a sporty look and a sporty grip.

Air Conditioning. Many people think of automotive air conditioning in the same terms as commercial air conditioning. They believe it is for use during only one season of the year, the summer, when it offers relief and cool comfort while driving on hot humid days. That's because they're only aware of one quarter of the story. The facts are, automotive air conditioning provides as many equally comforting advantages in winter, spring and fall as it does in the summer.

Four-Season Air Conditioning (available for V8 models only) is a manually-controlled air conditioning system that permits the driver to create an environment to suit his personal comfort at any time of the year. You set the controls so that the interior of the vehicle is heated . . . cooled . . . or a combination of both, to your preference. Four-Season Air Conditioning envelops occupants of the vehicle in a continuing supply of fresh, temperature-controlled, virtually water-washed and dried air,

largely free of the pollens and dust that cause so many people much distress. It is a blessing in disguise for those with hay fever and related health problems.

With Four-Season Air
Conditioning, you can drive with
the windows fully-closed in a
temperature and humidity controlled environment, free from the
annoyance of wind, wind whistles,
dust, driving rain and passing car's
wintry, slushy splash. Heavy
traffic noises are shut out so that you
can carry on a conversation without
straining or enjoy your favorite
radio program.

In addition to providing circulation of cool air during hot weather, Four-Season Air Conditioning provides warm air in cold weather and dehumidifies outside air in humid weather. Controls can be also set to de-fog and de-ice when such operations are required.

Four-Season Air Conditioning greatly increases driving comfort and pleasure during every season of the year. It also adds considerably to the resale value of the vehicle.

Space-Saver spare tire. A reduced profile tire that takes up less space allowing more room for luggage. To inflate, simply use the aerosol can included.




Radios. You can choose either an AM or AM/FM radio with pushbutton station selection. Factory installation includes antenna

In addition, all our engines are able to operate efficiently on unleaded, low leaded or any leaded regular gasoline with a research octane of 91 or higher.

Nevertheless new systems are continuously being explored and tested that should help us achieve our goals.

Meanwhile you can help by maintaining your own car in good operating condition and by having it tuned regularly.

And, in the area of safe motoring, you can help by having everyone in your car wearing seat belts when in motion and by driving defensively at all times.
