looking out across the classic windswept hood of The Hugger.



This is Camaro Z28. It's a very special machine for people who are dedicated to one ideal: performance. Z28 is the Camaro for peo-

ple not satisfied with the ordinary. Z28 starts with a potent 350-cubic-inch V8. Its impressive power and torque output is then teamed up with a four-speed gearbox (305-cubic-inch V8 and automatic transmission required in California) and a 3.08 rear end. Z28 announces itself with a unique

exhaust note from the standard dual resonators.

Chevy takes this highly respected powertrain and matches it with a tough performance suspension specially designed for the Z28. It includes hefty front and rear stabilizer bars and special heavy-duty shocks and springs.

Z28 is also one of the best-dressed cars on the street with a rear spoiler, front air dam, rear fender flares, white-lettered steel-belted radials and a bold new Z28 stripe and body-color grille.

Inside you can grip the large rim sport steering wheel and watch the kind of gages a driver needs, like a

tach, voltmeter, temperature gage, and electric clock—all standard.

For 1980 Z28 boasts new technical features like a functional solenoid-operated air-intake hood scoop and new, functional fender exhaust ports. Together they are designed to improve air recirculation under the hood.

Woven into this is the road-hugging heart of an American classic—Chevy Camaro. The Hugger. Drive a Z28. The Camaro for people who demand more than the ordinary.

CAMARO BERLINETTA.

Berlinetta continues the quiet sensation. It's a luxurious Camaro. Quiet. Comfortable. Yet, with a blend of sport styling and lean lines that puts a different accent on luxury.

Deluxe insulating package. Outside noise is reduced with an inner seat layer of sound-absorbing material, covered by a thick soft headliner that further reduces noise distractions. Bottom door seals are then added to help dampen vibration, wind and road noise.

Balanced riding ease. Berlinetta irons out bumps with a suspension package all its own that includes specially valved shocks, new front springs and relocated engine mounts.

Lush interior comfort. Tailored fabrics and deep foam comfort only start the list of distinctive features. There's also a bright-accented Gage Package with tachometer, voltmeter, temperature gage and electric clock as standard equipment in all Berlinettas.

Sophisticated exterior appointments. New bright grille and new wire wheel covers are an extra Berlinetta refinement this year. In addition, the white-stripe steel-belted radial ply tires, black-accented rocker panels and Berlinetta identification on the front end, trunk lid and rear roof panels all contribute to the Berlinetta's long, low, lean and luxurious lines.



CAMARO STANDARD FEATURES.

- Power steering. Puts you in touch with the road with little effort.
- Center floor console. Color-keyed to match interior. Includes floor shift lever.
- Front disc/rear drum brakes. A self-adjusting system. Force-resistant front disc brakes have audible wear sensors to let you know when to replace linings.
- Visible ball joint wear indicators. Located on front suspension lower control arms for visual check of ball joint wear.
- Inner fenders. Inner shield on front and rear fenders helps provide road splash protection.



6. Flow-through ventilation system. Outside air flows from outlets in the instrument panel, over front seats to

back seat and is returned back outside through the lower door pillars under all driving conditions.


7. Concealed windshield wipers. Disappear when wipers are switched off. Help preserve the clean, sculptured lines of hood and windshield.

8. Delco Freedom battery. Never needs refilling. Sealed side terminals help resist corrosion.

9. Wall-to-wall carpeting. Lush, cut-pile, color-keyed carpeting.

10. Contoured, full foam front bucket seats. Plus bucket-style full foam back seats.



Front coil and rear leaf suspension. Resilient coil springs at each front wheel and multi-leaf rear wheel springs are computer-selected to match each model and equipment weight.



Front stabilizer bar. Helps add stability to reduce body lean during sharp turns.



High Energy Ignition. A solid-state system that eliminates points and ignition condenser and delivers a high-voltage spark that helps extend life between recommended tune-ups.



Steel-belted radial-ply tires. Offer lower rolling resistance than conventional bias-ply tires plus impressive traction.



Anti-corrosion measures. Pre-coated steel is used for reinforcement and underbody crossbars, and ventilated rocker panels are designed to permit good air circulation and water drainage to help guard against corrosion.

ENGINE SELECTION

3.8 LITER V6s

These engines are new for 1980 and standard on all models except the Z28. Two variations of a 3.8 Liter V6 are used, the 231-cu.-in. version in California and the 229-cu.-in. version standard in the remaining 49 states. Both feature a "V6" design that is light in weight. They deliver impressive power and quick, even response. Hydraulic valve lifters help provide a smooth and quiet flow of power. They're engines that deliver performance for today's kind of driving.

4.4 LITER V8

This available V8 includes short-stroke valve-in-head design and Dualjet carburetor which help provide good engine performance at all speed ranges. Also features a cost-

iron cylinder block with full jacket cylinder cooling, a precision-balanced, cast-iron crankshaft, hydraulic valve lifters and exhaust valve rotators for even wear.

5.0 LITER V8

This available engine features short-stroke valve-in-head design and downdraft carburetor which help provide good engine performance at all speed ranges. You also get full jacket cylinder cooling, a precision-balanced crankshaft and hydraulic valve lifters.

5.7 LITER V8

The rugged Z28 powerplant has impressive low-speed torque for around-town cruising and is also very responsive on the highway.

2. Sound systems. Produced by Delco to General Motors quality standards. Many systems to select from, including: AM/FM/Citizens Band radio with power antenna, AM/FM stereo/Citizens Band radio with power antenna, AM/FM stereo radio with stereo 8-track tape, AM/FM stereo radio with stereo cassette tape and AM/FM stereo radio with digital clock display. 3. Gage Package with tachometer. Consists of electric clock, tachometer, voltmeter and temperature gage. Standard on Z28 and Berlinetta.

4. Automatic transmission. Shifts for you in three forward gears; can also be shifted manually.

5. Automatic speed control. Holds a steady speed without pressure on the accelerator. Disengages automatically when brake pedal is depressed.



Available with power brakes and automatic transmission only.

6. Comforttilt steering wheel. Adjusts to six different positions for most comfortable driving angle and for easy entry and exiting.

7. Custom styled wheels. Available on Sport Coupe and Rally Sport. Not available on Z28 or Berlinetta.

8. Aluminum wheels. Brand-new lightweight addition to Camaro this year, available in 15" x 7" on the Z28 and 14" x 7" on Berlinetta, Rally Sport and Sport Coupe.

9. Full wheel covers. Stainless steel to resist dirt and corrosion. Available for Sport Coupe only.

10. Power windows. Raise or lower windows at a touch of a button.

11. Power door lock system. This convenient feature locks both doors with the flick of a switch on either door.



A WORD ABOUT ASSEMBLY, COMPONENTS AND OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT IN THESE CHEVROLETS.

These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by various divisions of General Motors and by various suppliers to General Motors.
